The Mapungubwe National Park, located at the confluence of the Limpopo and Shashi Rivers in the North of the Limpopo Province, is host to the Three-banded Courser, Tropical Bou Bou, Meves (Long-tailed) Starling and Senegal Coucal, as well as a wide variety of Raptors. But, because of its proximity to Botswana and Zimbabwe, you can expect all sorts of species to turn up!

You'll be staying at the luxurious Tshugulu Bush Lodge, situated in a secluded corner of the Park. This spacious thatched accommodation offers superior en-suite rooms and spectacular views.

Activities include informative birdlife talks, morning and afternoon bird and open vehicle game drives in the company of Joe Grosel and Park Rangers, a visit to the tree top boardwalk overlooking the Limpopo River and a night drive in search of owls and nightjars.
